

Student's Health Care

SUS – Unified Health System

UNILA's Student Health Care is carried out through the Unified Health System (SUS), which is one of the largest public health systems in the world. It ranges from simple outpatient care to organ transplantation, ensuring comprehensive, universal and free access for the entire population of the country.

How to access SUS?

To have access to SUS, students must carry the **National Health Card** (SUS Card). Students who do not have it will be able to do so at the Basic Health or Family Health Unit (UBS or USF) closest to their home. For **Brazilian students**, it is necessary to present proof of enrollment (issued by SIGAA), proof of residence, CPF and RG. For **non-Brazilians**, it is necessary to present proof of enrollment (issued by SIGAA), proof of residence (validated by PROINT or reception of PRAE), CPF and RNE.

Looking for Assistance/Health Care

The health care in our city is territorialized, that is, the students are assisted at the UBS or USF closest to their residence. After establishing your residence, it is important that after its completion is more important. They work at different times and use a variety of health services. We list below as UBS / USF distributors in the northern district of the city, near the **campus JU** and **PTI**:

- **USF Porto Belo:** Av. Zacarias Vitelino da Silva s/n. Porto Belo, from 07:00 to 15:00. Tel: 3524-9580.

-USFs **ITAIPU C:**

This neighborhood has two USF, one of them at Street A, s / n, which runs from 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Tel: 3901-3416 / 3521-9829. The other one is at Rua O, s / n - next to Padre Luigi School and it answers from 7:30 to 11:30 and from 13:00 to 17:00. Tel: 3901-3417 / 3521-9582

- **USF Cidade Nova:** Street Antônio Polini, 160. Cidade Nova, from 7:30 to 11:30 and from 13:00 to 17:00. Tel: 3521-9571 / 3575-8356

- **CRF KLP:** Street Belo Horizonte, 100. KLP, from 7:00 to 18:00. Tel: 3901-3413

UBS for residents in the Downtown:

- **UBS Jd América:** Rua Di Cavalcanti, s/n. Jd. América (in front of the municipal school Elenice Melhorança), from 7:00 to 19:00. Tel: 3901-3443 / 3901-3444.

Advise: For assistance at the UBS or urgency and emergency care always take the SUS Card and your personal documents.

Emergency Care

If you need medical care out of UBS hours or on weekends and holidays, go to a UPA – Emergency Care Unit. These units operate 24 hours a day for urgency and emergencies. In these places, the service is not given on a first come, first served basis. Therefore, the care can be very fast (even more serious cases) or may require you to wait for some time to be assisted. UPAs are located at the following addresses:

- **UPA Jardim das Palmeiras** (Next to Vila A): Street Iacanga, s/n – corner with Av. Sílvio Américo Sasdelli. Telephone: 2105-8000.

- **UPA Morumbi:** Av. Mário Filho, s/n. Primeiro de Maio. Telephone: 2105-8050.

In cases such as fainting, convulsion, severe burns, severe bleeding wounds, animal bites, severe pain (chest,

abdomen and spine), heart and breathing problems, labor, suspected stroke, poisoning, etc; you must activate the Emergency Mobile Answering Service (SAMU) dialing 192.

Important: In case of traumas (traffic accidents, falls, drownings and fractures) who should be activated is the SIATE dialing 193.

DEAS

The Dean of Student Affairs (PRAE) through DEAS - Department of Health Care, has a team of professionals who develop actions of prevention, promotion and attention to the health of students, with emphasis on the community. Among the actions developed are: medical and nursing care, receipt and certification of certificates filed by students, distribution of female and male condoms and health informative / educational materials, performing procedures such as vaccines, dressings and vital signs, as well as guidance on access to health services available in the SUS network in the municipality.
